

Careers Guidance Meetings

We buy in the services of a L6 Careers Adviser from Complete Careers. Careers guidance professionals are trained to a minimum of Level 6 and are registered with the CDI (Career Development Institute) and adhere to their code of ethics.

During a guidance meeting, the following areas may be explored:

- Strengths/skills/values
- Experience so far
- What is important to the student
- The types of things a students might like to explore further
- Any existing ideas
- Where to find useful information/resources
- Tools to make informed decisions
- Any areas of concern

A Careers Adviser will not make decisions for a student but will help them develop their career management skills so that they are able to make decisions about their progression routes.
