Is the same system used for all year groups?

Not quite. We monitor pupil attainment in Years 7 & 8 using ‘Projected GCSE **Grade Bands**’. As the pupils are still at a very early stage of their learning, it is too soon to confidently award a specific 9-1 grade. Therefore, we feel that the bands are a more useful indicator at this stage. This gives pupils a chance to get used to the GCSE grading system that we use from Year 9 onwards. A pupil’s grade band in any given subject represents the teacher’s view of how current work, homework, effort and attitude to learning are most likely to translate into a GCSE grade. Please be assured that all departments routinely track and monitor the progress and attainment of all pupils, and help and support are provided accordingly.

What do the bands actually represent?

The range within which individual PROJECTED GCSE GRADES currently fall. There is no such thing as a ‘Current Working Grade’ based on ‘flight paths of progress’ at SHS. *The destination is the focus, not the journey.*

NB: ‘+’ bands = progress made **within** a band between spring and summer
