146 students in the cohort

Year 13:

There were 100 students in the cohort.

University applications:

- 68 students (68%) gained a place at university for 2026 entry and 5 students with deferred entry places for 2027.

Of the 68 students who secured a university place:

- 45 students gained entry to their first-choice university (66% of those who applied to university)
- 10 students secured their insurance choice university place
- 12 students secured a university place through clearing

Students have chosen 35 different universities with 8 students going to Leeds Beckett University. 21 students (31%) are going to Russell Group universities and the Russell Group universities with most students securing a place are the University of Nottingham (4 students) and the University of York (4 students).

The one student who had a conditional offer for Medicine was successful in gaining their place.

For the fourth successive year, the most popular degree discipline was Law (6 students).

Progression routes other than university:

32 students (32%) have a progression route for 2026-2027 as follows (this includes the 5 deferred entry for September 2027 university applicants):

- 14 students have or are seeking jobs (these may be in roles they had previously during sixth form until they decide on alternative plans/positions)
- 3 students have apprenticeships
- 11 students are working or volunteering as part of a gap year before applying/re-applying/going to university
- 4 students have enrolled on FE courses locally.

Summary:

68 students (68%) gained a university place for 2026 entry and 32 students (32%) have an alternative progression route for 2026-2027 (this latter statistic includes deferred entry students who will go to university in 2027 and are on a gap year this year).

Our students continue to be extremely successful in achieving their desired progression route.
