Day 1 - Fly to Croatia



Day 1 — Check into the Porto Hotel, Zadar



Day 1 - Explore Zadar



Zadar is known for the Roman and Venetian ruins of its peninsular old town, including several Venetian gates in the city walls. Surrounding the Roman-era Forum are the 11th-century St. Mary's Convent, with religious art dating to the 8th century; the grand, 12th-century St. Anastasia's Cathedral; and the round, 9thcentury pre-Romanesque Church of St. Donat.



Day 2 - Kornati National Park



Boat trip to the Kornati National Park. Located in the northern part of the Dalmatia it is an unsual park because it is entirely made from an archipelago with the highest density of islands in the entire Mediterranean; there are 109 islands in total with 76 less than 1 hectare in size! The islands have been pronounced a national park and because of this they maintain their biodiversity and are home to a rich maritime ecosystem.

Day 3 — Transfer to the Lovran Link Hostel





Day 3 - Plitvice Lakes



The oldest National Park in Croatia and a UNESCO site, the Plitvice lakes. The Park contains a series of beautiful lakes, caves and waterfalls. These have been formed by processes typical of karst landscapes such as the deposition of travertine barriers, creating natural dams. These geological processes continue today. You will enjoy a walking tour with a guide and a boat ride over the largest lake Kozjak.

Day 4 - Lungo Mare and Ucka Mountain



A morning walk along a portion of Lungo Mare, a sea promenade that extends from Volosko to Lovran

Visit Učka Mountain for a hike to Vela Draga canyon valley - a natural monument and one of the most beautiful geomorphological phenomena in Croatia.

The Učka is a mountain range that rises behind Opatija riviera, on the Istrian peninsula, in northwestern Croatia. It differs from all the other coastal mountains in Croatia because of its abundant vegetation on the seaward side.



Day 5 - Explore Louvran

Situated on the banks of the Adriatic Sea and surrounded by the tall, thick pine trees and indigenous underbrush of nearby Ucka Mountain, this picturesque town embodies the spirit of the Mediterranean.



Day 5 - Depart Croatia, Arrive UK



Summary of main excursions

- Boat trip to Kornati National Park. Located in the northern part of the Dalmatia it is an unsual park because it is entirely made from an archipelago with the highest density of islands in the entire Mediterranean.
