Dear parents and carers,

I would like to start by saying how proud we are of all of the students. Despite the difficult circumstances, they have continued to adapt and focus on making the most of learning opportunities and continue to submit work of high quality. Home learning places a considerable responsibility on our students and it is encouraging to see so many tackling challenges with resilience and maturity. We are also aware of the stress that this can sometimes place on parents and carers and we thank you also for your continued support.

We appreciate that some students may find this situation and method of working difficult, needing reassurance and support or more practical advice on managing their workload at home. I would urge any student struggling to contact their teacher so that support and advice can be given. Students must not worry about asking teachers for additional help to complete tasks. Work for Phase 5 (15th June to 26th June) is now available on the School website. As before, Year 9 students are only expected to complete work for their compulsory subjects and their GCSE options choices. The compulsory subjects are English, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, a language (for the great majority this will be their designated language studied since Year 7), Religious Studies and Geography or History. In a slight change to our original plan, Phase 6 has been extended so that it now runs from 29th June to 21st July.
