Government Plans for September.

I am sure that you will have seen that elements of the Government's plans for full school returns in September have begun to be leaked through the media. The DfE regulations are due for release this week however, we have continued to work proactively on our plans for September for many weeks now. As soon as we receive the DfE regulations we will work to implement them and adjust our risk assessments accordingly. These will be shared with students and parents as soon as they are ready.
